

# MariEMS April 2017 News

The MariEMS UK Multiplier event was held at Warwick University on 29 March during an IMarEST programme. Attendees were mainly marine engineers, along with some attendees who were experts from other maritime and technological fields. The event brought together Marine Engineer Professionals from across the regions in order to gather feedback and industry responses to the newly developed MariEMS Energy Manager Job Specifications and Training Programme.

This multiplier event was titled: 'Maritime - The Efficient Ship'.

The attendees were initially given a brief introduction of MariEMS project by Project Coordinator Captain Zakirul Bhuiyan (ZB) and then a handout about job and training specifications was provided to all. After the introduction, Prof. Dr. Reza Ziarati (RZ) gave a presentation on 'Efficient ship', which highlighted the importance of energy management on board and its link to MariEMS project.

On completion of the presentation there was a question and answer session, where ZB, RZ, and Kunal Anand (KA) fielded various questions about the topic from the attendees. This also provided a platform for the verbal feedback on Output 1 and 2 of the MariEMS project. After the Q & A session evaluation/feedback forms were provided to all the attendees and they were welcomed to provide written feedback on the Output 1 and 2.
